Directions: Take I-205 to Oregon City (exit #9); then take Hwy 99E towards Canby. In Canby, turn left on Ivy Street (stoplight after the fairgrounds) and drive about 8 miles south (Ivy Street becomes the Canby/Marquam Hwy 170) to the stoplight at Hwy 211 (You're now on Kropf Rd). Drive 3/4 mile towards the little village of Yoder. We are on the right hand side of the road. Look for the sign on our metal gate that says "SuDan Farm." We are just 2 doors north of the historic Yoder Store. (Call if you need travel directions from other locations.)
